The meeting was opened with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Department Reports:

Town Engineer James Wyzykiewicz mentioned he would like the Town Board to move forward with the Sigman Lane/Highland Drive Drainage Project pending no issues with residents. Five plans were picked up but only one bid was submitted for \$45,400. Seven residents are affected in this area. The Town Board would like to wait until the next Town Board Meeting on September 4, 2019 to move forward on this project to allow time to hear from all residents affected. Mr. Wyzykiewcz was asked about the status of the Woodard Road easement. Mr. Wyzykiewicz stated that Mr. Hawkins has been non-responsive to any contact and has not signed off on the easement, therefore there will be no moving forward. Building Inspector Joseph Colern presented the monthly report for July with 47 permits issues, fees collected of \$11,732.96 with an estimated value of construction of \$1,581,877.20. Plant Manager Brian Fiden noted last month the Water Dept sold some equipment which included an enclosed trailer. The Water Department has an old generator to dispose of and Building Inspector Joe Colern needs to contact an electrician regarding the generator for use at the Town Hall. If the generator is not able to be used, Brian would like to sell it at auction. Fire hydrants were replaced in front of the school and at the intersection of Northrup and Kinsley Roads. Highway Superintendent Wayne Clark noted the cabin chassey for the new plow truck came in and road repairs are being done on Kinsley Rd and Boll Dr.
